Dear Eurolinguists,

The 2013 EHP Eurolinguistics proceedings have just been published as volume of the *Journal for EuroLinguistiX* (available at www.eurolinguistix.com > Journal). We can now offer an interesting (still a bit preliminary) program for the next EHP conference. It will take place from 4-6 April 2014, again in the small town of Pappenheim in the lovely Altmühl valley. The conference deals with the connections of Eurolinguistic aspects with other disciplines.
